



BTEC Level 1 / 2 Award in Health and Social Care

COURSE OUTLINE:

This course has three components that focus on the assessment of knowledge, skills and practices which are essential to those working in the fields of health, social care and early years. The course will help learners to:

- Acquire knowledge of development through the life stages
- Understand the care values and working practices in a vocational setting
- Understand the well-being of individuals in health and social care

Why should I study health and social care?

Health and social care provides knowledge and skills which are beneficial to students who are considering a career in health, social care or early years. The course enables students to achieve a level 2 qualification in care which can be useful when applying for work experience, apprenticeships or employment within the sector. The course also has natural routes of progression onto higher and further education courses in social sciences, early years and health care.
