Geographical information systems (GIS) is quickly becoming an important part of lots of businesses. GIS are computerised systems that are used to collect, store, analyse and present complex geographical information. GIS managers who work in the offshore wind power industry are involved in the production and analysis of data to help plan, deliver and maintain offshore wind farms.	Geographic support technicians produce the information that allows commanders to understand their surroundings and plan missions effectively. They put together and manage geographic data from a variety of sources, using advanced computer software and geographic information systems.	Geography teachers prepare and deliver lessons to young people aged 11 to 16 years old, or up to 19 years old in sixth forms, about the Earth's natural features and mankind's responses to them. They often take students on field trips to collect samples or do map work of an area.
